<u>Community School Student Scholarship</u> - this scholarship is available to all students who are currently enrolled in a two-year school of nursing program!

<u>Single Parent Student Scholarship</u> - this scholarship is available to all students who are currently enrolled in any school of nursing while also being a single parent!

<u>2nd Degree Nursing Scholarship</u> - this scholarship is available to all students who already have a degree in another field but are currently enrolled in a school of nursing!
